

REGULATIONS OF



I. GENERAL PROVISION

1. The provisions of these Regulations are intended to protect the rights of all visitors to the campsite, determine their behavior and use of the provided facilities and equipment.

II. ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

1. Immediately upon arrival, the guest is obliged to check in at the campsite reception desk by submitting their identity card and the number of Persons accompanying him.
2. The entire stay is paid in total until the day of departure. A VAT invoice for the cost of stay is issued upon the guest's request.
3. Prepaid but unused stay will not be reimbursed, unless the unused stay is related to random events occurring on the guest's side.
4. Guests are requested to report any visitors at the campsite reception desk, and their visit at the campsite after 8 pm. is possible after the payment of a visitor fee in the amount of 1 night stay. In the absence of such a notification or/and lack of paid visitor fee, the campsite will charge the same amount as aforementioned.

III. ACCOMMODATION AND CAMPSITE RULES

1. The emplacement number at the campsite shall be allocated and agreed with the reception staff.
2. It is forbidden to change the emplacement number without prior permission from the reception staff.
3. Children should be supervised by their parents or carers.
Children may use the equipment, playgrounds, etc. only under the supervision of their persons mentioned above. The campsite management is not responsible for possible injuries, or damages to children, if they do not comply with the aforementioned conditions.
4. It is forbidden to park vehicles on the internal roads of the campsite.
5. At the campsite, the maximum speed of motor vehicles shall be adapted to the specific conditions and situations, up to 20 km / h.
6. Before departure, the Guest is obliged to leave their place clean and natural looking.

IV. FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT

1. Guests may use all facilities and equipment available at the campsite according to their design.
2. Washing and laundry may only be carried out in areas designed especially for that purpose.
3. It is forbidden to wash cars, change the oil in the vehicle, etc.
4. Washbasins, showers, urinals and toilets may only be used according to their design.
5. Please report any faults to the campsite staff.

V. STORAGE OF PERSONAL BELONGING AND RESPONSIBILITY FOR INJURIES AT THE CAMPING

1. The guest, and other visitors to the campsite are obliged to take due care for their own property at the campsite.
2. The camping management is not responsible for cars, valuables and personal belongings left on its premises.
3. The campsite management is not responsible for any accidents or personal injury not resulting from the camp's sole fault.

VI. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

1. Only waste containers marked 'segregacja odpadów' and bins are designated for waste storage.
2. At the campsite, it is required to take care of the natural environment.

VII. QUIET HOURS AND PEACE DISTURBANCE

1. Night silence is valid from 10 pm. 6 am.
2. It is forbidden to:
 - lit fires - apart from places designated for that purpose,
 - install additional equipment, installations, small architectural elements without prior consultation with the campsite staff.
3. Events with elevated acoustics may be held at the 'MOLO RESORT' up to 11 pm.

VIII. OTHER RULES

1. Dogs (in muzzles or other mouthguards allowed by the law) may be kept at the campsite and in its vicinity under appropriate to their temper control of their owner or guardian.
2. The staff is available to help with any questions for all important matters concerning the stay at the campsite.

IX. BREACHES OF THE REGULATIONS AND THEIR CONSEQUENCES

1. In case of non-compliance with the provisions of these Regulations, the offender may be removed from the campsite and may be obliged to cover the cost of any damage to the campsite. In the absence of an amicable settlement, the camp will take appropriate and adequate legal action.
